(a) to (c): The second phase of the United Kingdom-India Education and Research Initiative (UKIERI-II) has been launched for the period from 2011-2015. The Initiative covers the entire country including West Bengal. Major elements of the Initiative are:-

Leadership Development - building leadership capacity in schools, colleges and universities.

Innovation Partnerships - enhancing the innovation capacity of further and higher education institutions.

Skills Development - enabling the UK skills sector to support India with its ambition to train 500 million people by 2022.

Enhancing Mobility - through the mutual recognition of learning and achievements.

Under this project, some UK Universities have shown interest in collaboration/tie up with counterpart institutions in India.
