(a): Yes, Sir. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between India and Canada on cooperation in the field of Higher Education was signed on 27.06.2010.

(b): The MoU provides for exchanges of students, organization of workshops and seminars, exchange of research materials and publications, twinning arrangements between institutions of higher learning and promotion of teaching and research. It aims to bring together institutions of educational excellence in technical, vocational and higher education through education and training programmes, besides providing mutual assistance in education in the fields of educational planning and management, social sciences, information technology, computer science, mathematics, science, nanotechnology and bio-technology. The MOU enables both countries to explore possibilities of mutual recognition of educational qualifications and to undertake reciprocal internship programs in areas of mutual interest.

(c): The MoU has come into force from the date of signing on 27.06.2010.
