(d) if so, the details thereof;

(e) whether the Union Government proposes to have a relook at the entrance examination system in the country;

(f) if so, the details thereof; and

(g) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (d): Yes, Sir. The Prime Minister's Scientific Advisory Council has recommended that there should be only one national examination which should be able to assess the eligibility of the candidates.

(e) to (g): The Government has setup a Committee headed by Dr. T. Ramasami, Secretary, Department of Science & Technology to assess the examination and admission system in engineering programmes. The committee has not yet submitted its report.
