(a) to (c): As per available information, 66 proposals were received from the Government of Madhya Pradesh under various schemes for promoting education in the State during the last three years and the current year. All these proposals except one have been approved and necessary sanctions have been issued. The remaining one proposal pertaining to Saakshar Bharat Programme for Adult Literacy will be considered in the current financial year.
