- (a) to (c): "A new passage to India" has been initiated by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) on behalf of the German Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF). The objective of the initiative is to kindle interest among Indian students of all disciplines and courses to study, carry out research or gain experience in the working environment in Germany and to encourage German students to gain the same experiences in India. The three main schemes under this programme are:-
- I. Study and Research Stays within Academic Co-operations.
- II. Working and Research Internships.
- III. Indo-German Centres.
