(a) whether a large number of applications from the kin of militants from Jammu and Kashmir have been submitted to the Government for rehabilitation;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether militants whose names have been cleared by the joint screening committee are still awaiting for rehabilitation;

(d) if so, the details thereof; and

(e) the details of the steps taken to expedite the rehabilitation process in the State?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH)

(a): Yes, Madam.

(b): The agencies of the State Government have received about 750 applications from the kin of those who crossed over to POK/Pakistan.

(c) to (e): A Joint Screening Committee of the State Government has initially cleared 12 names. The policy for return of ex-militants finalized by Government of J & K provides for rehabilitation by training of returnees in suitable skills, after their return to the State.
