Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a large number of Kashmiris are missing from the valley;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government in this regard and to address the grievances of families of Kashmiris who are missing from the valley?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH)

- (a): Yes, Madam. There have been reports about Kashmiris missing from the Valley. However, specific details are not available.
- (b): As per the information furnished by Government ofg J&K, during the initial period of last two decades when the militancy was on the rise, a large number of Kashmiris are reported to have been crossed over to Pok/Pakistan. A number of them are reported to have been killed on the LOC while attempting to cross over.
- (c): In order to enable return of misguided Kashmiri youths who have crossed over to PoK/Pakistan, a policy has been framed by Government of J&K recently.
