SATELLITE TOWNSHIP FOR DISPLACED KASHMIRIS

**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Prime Minister recently inaugurated a satellite township in Jagati and Nagrota to provide permanent houses to displaced Kashmiris;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total estimated cost of the scheme and the source of funding;
- (d) the total number of families settled/to be settled under this scheme; and
- (e) the time by which this scheme is likely to be completed?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) to (e): Yes, Madam. The Hon'ble Prime Minister inaugurated the completed flats of the township at Jagati (Nagrota) on 4.3.2011 for providing temporary accommodation to Kashmiri Migrants. Construction of 4218 flats alongwith all allied works was taken up in 2006. 3504 flats have already been completed and 3300 families have occupied these flats so far. The total estimated cost for construction of flats is Rs. 334.00 crores and the scheme is being funded under the Hon'ble Prime Minister's Reconstruction Plan sanctioned for J&K State. The scheme is expected to be completed shortly.
