- (d) whether the funds have been utilized;
- (e) if so, the details thereof, State-wise and Union Territory-wise; and
- (f) if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) A statement indicating details of proposals received from the Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) working for the welfare of disabled under the Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation Scheme (DDRS) and the Scheme of Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase and Fitting of Aids and Appliances (ADIP), is at Annexure-I.
- (b) Clearance of proposals is an ongoing process and is subject to completeness of the proposals, their conformity to the norms of respective schemes, General Financial Rules and availability of funds.
- (c) to (f) The Integrated Education for Disabled Children (IEDC) scheme has been replaced by the new scheme of Inclusive Education for the Disabled at Secondary Stage (IEDSS) w.e.f 1.4.2009. A statement indicating details of funds (State-wise/Union Territory-wise) released during 2008-09 under the erstwhile IEDC scheme is at Annexure-II and statement indicating the details of funds released from 2009-10 to 2011-12(upto 31.8.2011) under the new scheme of IEDSS is at Annexure-III.
