- (d)if so, the details thereof, sector-wise and State-wise; and
- (e)the details of measures taken or proposed to be taken to ensure unhindered growth of those sectors?

Answer

- (a) No specific study on the overall impact of Maoist and other organisations' terrorist activities on the growth of the economy has been carried out.

- (c) Law and order is an essential component of the economic environment of the country. Terrorist activities vitiate this environment and affect growth adversely. 'Police' and 'Public Order' being State subjects, action with respect to maintenance of law and order lies primarily in the domain of the concerned State Governments, who deal with the various issues related to public order & security. The Central Government closely monitors the situation and supplements the efforts of the State Governments over a wide range of schemes, both on security and development fronts.
