Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR MINES (SHRI DINSHA PATEL)

(a) & (b): No, Madam. There is no proposal or scheme in the Ministry of Mines to give additional funds for development of mineral rich tribal areas. However, the National Mineral Policy, 2008, enunciates that stakeholder rights of host and indigenous population shall be protected through developing models of stakeholder interest based on international best practices. Suitable legislation to back the policy is under consideration of the Government.
