- (a) & (b): Improvement of amenities is a continuous process. Minimum essential amenities are already available at Cheriyanad Railway station.
- (c) & (d): At present, no such proposal to change/shift the railway terminal at Changanacherry station in Kerala has been received. However, as a part of doubling project, there is a proposal for providing new station building at this station.
