## Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to raise the import and export duty on iron ore;

(b) if so, the details there of and reasons therefor;

(c) whether the Government proposes to hike the import duty on structural steel and reinforcement bars;

(d) if so, the extent to which such steps are likely to help to avoid dumping of steel by Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS);

(e) whether imposition of 15 per cent ad-valorem duty on chrome ore and chrome ore concentrates is under the consideration of the Government; and

(f) if so, the details and the steps taken by the Government to abolish customs duty on ship-breaking?
