## Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up specialised research centres or hospitals in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Haryana; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government in this regard so far?

## **Answer**

(a) to (c): Indian Council of Medical Research under the Department of Health Research has 31 permanent Institutes/Specialized Research Centres (Andhra Pradesh: 3; Assam: 1; Bihar: 1; Delhi: 3; Gujarat: 1; Karnataka: 2; Madhya Pradesh: 2; Maharashtra: 7; Orissa: 1; Rajasthan: 1; Tamil Nadu: 3; Uttar Pradesh: 2; West Bengal: 2; Pondicherry: 1; Andaman & Nicobar: 1). Besides, Department of Scientific & Industrial Research (though Council of Scientific & Industrial Research) also conduct research through their Institutes/research centres. The need for new centres is assessed from time to time based on requirements.
