- (d) the action plan drawn by the Government to control these diseases and provide proper and affordable treatment to such patients?

(a) & (b) The number of reported cases of major communicable diseases for the last three years and the current year are given in Annexure.

It shows that the trends of decrease or increase are variable across different diseases.

(c) & (d) The transmission of communicable diseases depends on various environmental and man-made factors. The Government of India is implementing various preventive and control programmes to address communicable diseases. Besides, under National Rural Health Mission (NRHM), the Government of India is supporting States/UTs in improving their infrastructure for better delivery of primary health care services.
