(a) whether some discrepancies have been reported in conduct of medical entrance tests in certain medical colleges including Tripura Medical College in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof during the last three years and the current year so far, State/UT-wise; and

(c) the action taken/proposed by the Government thereon?

(a) to (c): During the last three years, only one case pertaining to admission of 32 students belonging to the ST category in the State Medical Colleges of Jharkhand on the basis of Jharkhand Combined Entrance Competitive Examination Board, has come to the notice of the Central Government. However, the matter could not be taken up with the Medical Council of India till recently due to non-receipt of details from the State Government of Jharkhand.
