(a) At present, the products manufactured by the Indian Machine Tools Industry mainly meets the requirements of the standard and mid size machine tools in manual and lower end Computerized Numerically Controlled (CNC) machines. The industry has technology gaps in certain areas like grinding, gear cutting, high precision machine tools, multi-axes and multi-function machines, large/ heavy duty machines and metal forming machines
