- (a) the details of extension of railway lines proposed to be undertaken in the current Financial Year in the country, State-wise;
- (b) whether any such proposal for Purvanchal in Uttar Pradesh is pending with the Railways;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the time by which a decision is likely to be taken thereon?

(a) to (d): During the current financial year, 11 New Railway Line projects covering 1166 Kms in various States in the country have been taken up at a Cost of Rs. 7047 Crore. At present, no proposal for construction of New Railway Line in Purvanchal in Uttar Pradesh is pending with the Railways.
