- (a) the present status of doubling work on Udhna-Galgaon, Gandhidham-Kandla Port and Gandhidham-Adipur sections;
- (b) the time by which work on the said lines is likely to be completed; and
- (c) the reasons for delay in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

- (a) & (b): Doubling of Gandhidham-Kandla Port (12 km) and Gandhidham-Adipur (8 km) sections have been completed. Doubling of Udhna-Jalgaon (306.93 km) with electrification is in progress. Doubling of Amalner-Dharangaon (25 km) section is planned to be completed by September, 2011 and Vyar-Chinchpada (60 km) by March, 2012. The entire project is likely to be completed by March, 2014.
- (c): Does not arise, as the project has been progressed commensurate with the availability of funds.
