- (b) the reasons for delay in this regard; and
- (c) the time by which work on the said line is likely to be completed?

(a) Katangi-Tirodi new line has been sanctioned at a cost of Rs. 119.64 crore in 2011-12. Preliminary activities including Final Location Survey work has been taken up.

There is no sanctioned survey for the stretch from Amagon-Lauzi-Kiranpur. However, survey from Laji to Kirnapur has been sanctioned in 2011-12.

- (b) There is no delay in execution of project.
- (c) Target date for completion has not been fixed.
