STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 5764 BY SHRI K.D. DESHMUKH TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 08.09.2011 REGARDING BALAGHAT-JABALPUR RAILWAY LINE

- (a)&(b): The gauge conversion work on Balaghat-Nainpur-Jabalpur line is a part of the sanctioned gauge conversion project of Gondia-Jabalpur (including Balaghat-Katangi branch line). The sections from Gondia to Balaghat and Balaghat to Katangi have been completed and commissioned. Overall physical progress of the work is 63%. The forest land in Balaghat and Seoni districts has not yet been handed over. Matter is being pursued with Ministry of Environment and Forest.
- (c): The sanctioned cost for Gondia–Jabalpur (including Balaghat–Katangi branch line) gauge conversion project is Rs. 1037.90 crore. An outlay of Rs. 100 crore has been provided in the Budget 2011-12 and an expenditure of Rs. 520.42 crore has been incurred on the project upto March 2011.
- (d): The work is targeted for completion within 3 years after possession of required land is handed over to Railways.
