- (a) whether the Directorate General of Hydrocarbon (DGH) does not have its own cadre and its manpower is totally based on deputation;
- (b) the manner in which it is affecting the working of the Directorate along with the reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (c) the reasons for not formulating its cadre so far?

Answer

(a) to (c): Directorate General of Hydrocarbons (DGH) does not have a cadre of its own. In accordance with Government's Resolution dated 08.04.1993, DGH's manpower requirement is met by staff drawn from oil industry on deputation/ tenure basis in consultation with Director General(DG), DGH. In addition. DG, DGH also appoints specialists as considered necessary as consultants/advisers on contract basis. The present system of staffing in DGH meets the necessary requirements.
