- (a) and (b):- Government of India has constituted a high level National Bird Control Committee (NBCC) under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Civil Aviation. To deal with the issues of wildlife (bird/ animal) strike, a core group has been set up by Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) to work as a Central Agency in the field of wildlife (bird/ animal) strike prevention.
- (c):- The core group will implement action plan in approximately six months time.
