(a),(b)&(c): Yes,Sir.However,priority sector,which presently consists of 40% of the adjusted net bank credit, is already crowded with agriculture occupying around 45% of the space and the balance 55% shared by housing, micro, small & medium enterprises (MSME), retail and other sectors.In view of this position and the fact that renewable power projects are generally capital intensive,little room is left for priority lending to such projects.
