(a) and (b): The National Commission for Minorities (NCM) in their Annual Report 1998- 1999 had made a reference to the issue of settling minority status for Jains in India.

(c) The matter of giving minority status to Jains is presently under review of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and hence no time frame can be given at this stage.
