Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether CBSE has abolished Board Exam in Class X from 2010;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the present policy in this regard; and
- (c) the number of students who opted for Board Exam during 2010?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (DR. D. PURANDESWARI)

(a) & (b): Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has made Board Exam in class X optional from 2011. Those students who wish to remain in CBSE system after class X do not require to appear in the Board Examination. The students who wish to leave CBSE system after class X require to appear in the Board Examination conducted by CBSE.

(c): 9,02,747 students were registered for class X Board Examination during 2010.
