(a) & (b) Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India has published a report on India's Green House Gas (GHG) emissions by sources and removals by sinks for the year 2007 such as Carbon dioxide, Methane and Nitrous Oxide for energy, industry, agriculture waste and Land Use Land Use Change & Forestry sectors at national level. However, no specific studies have been conducted to assess the reduction of GHG emissions in metro cities.
