- (a) whether the some companies including Steel Authority of India Limited has sought permission for mining in 'Chiria reserves' in Jharkhand:
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

(a) to (c) There are 10 mining leases in Chiria. The six leases, namely, Buddhaburu, Ajitaburu, Dhobil, Sukri Luturburu, Anqua, and Tatiburu belong to SAIL and remaining four mining leases belong to Sesa Goa Limited, JSW Steel Limited, Essar Private Limited and Tata Steel Limited.

The Central Government has, so far, granted stage-I approval for renewal of diversion of 194.312 ha of already broken up forest land and diversion of 400.763 ha of additional forest land in favour of M/s SAIL. The State Government has also granted prospecting permission to mining lease of M/s Essar Private Limited. The details of these mining leases are annexed.
