- (a): The Government is taking concerted steps towards achieving Millennium Development Goal of ensuring that by 2015 all children are able to complete a full course of primary schooling. The Right of Children for Free and Compulsory Education (RTE) Act, 2009, which has come with effect from 1.4.2010, is being implemented to provide free and compulsory admission, attendance and completion of elementary education of all children in the age group 6-14 years.
- (b) & (c): The State-wise details of number of children who have completed class I to V during 2007-08, 2008-09 and 2009-10 is enclosed.
