(a) to (c): A Central Board of Vocational Education had been proposed by the Department of School Education and Literacy during the revision of the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Vocationalisation of Secondary Education, which was not accepted. However, the establishment of a specialized cell within the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) was recommended. A Vocational Cell has been created in the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) with 4 units namely (i) Administrative & Finance Unit (ii) Curriculum and Research & Development (iii) Assessment Unit and (iv) Affiliation Unit.
