(a) to (d): The High Level Committee (HLC) headed by Shri V.K. Shunglu has submitted six reports and the Ministry of Home Affairs has been assigned the task to examine the 3rd Report on "City Infrastructure". The comments of Government of NCT of Delhi, Ministry of Urban Development and other concerned agencies were called thereon. The reports and the replies of the concerned Departments have been examined and the comments/report of this Ministry are in advance stage of finatisation.

The Government has constituted a Group of Ministers(GOM) to look into the issues relating to the reports of the High Level Committee and consider the views expressed on the findings and recommendations by the concerned Ministries/Departments/ Governments including the Ministry of Home Affairs.
