- (a) & (b): Coastal States like Gujarat, kerala and Tamil Nadu have requested Government of India for setting up of National Marine Police Academy/National Marine Police Training Institute.
- (c) & (d): There is no proposal to provide assistance to the State Governments for setting up of National Marine Police Academy.
- (e): Training requirements of Marine Police, for performing marine duties, are effectively and timely met by Indian Coast Guard. So far 2346 Marine Police personnel have been trained by Indian Coast Guard.
