Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the work regarding construction of four lane road from Jalandhar By-pass to Dhilwan-Amritsar section is stalled for a long time;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor alongwith the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government for its speedy completion;
- (c) whether the Government has allotted funds for construction of this stretch as per the norms set by NHAI; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the construction of the said stretch is likely to be completed?

- (a) Four laning of Jalandhar-Amritsar section from km 407.100 to 456.100 (Dhilwan-Amritsar) is provisionally completed on 29.04.2010 on BOT basis. However, upgradation of Jalandhar bypass to Dhilwan section from km 387.100 to km 407.100 of NH-1 is yet to be taken up.
