Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government of Rajasthan has made a request for financial assistance as well as foreign assistance for the purpose of urban development during each of the last three years ;
- (b) if so, the details thereof ;
- (c) the action taken by the Government so far in this regard; and
- (d) the outcome thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA ROY)

(a) to (d): Yes Madam, under Urban Infrastructure Governance (UIG) Sub-Mission of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM), three projects have been approved for Rajasthan, with the approved cost of Rs 401.40 crore with Additional Central Assistance (ACA) of Rs. 234.32 crore during the last three years i.e. 2008-09 to 2010-11. An amount of Rs 202.81 crore and Rs. 28.26 crore has been released during 2008-09 and 2009-10 respectively.

Under Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Town (UIDSSMT), 37 projects in 35 towns have been approved for Rajasthan, with the approved cost of Rs 609.89 crore with Additional Central Assistance (ACA) of Rs. 490.63 crore during the last three years, i.e., 2008-09 to 2010-11, out of which an amount of Rs 191.82 crore, has been released during 2008-09.
