(a)&(b): Yes, Madam. Government of Odisha has submitted a proposal for revision of the project cost to Rs. 13064.00 lakh from the approved cost of Rs. 6833.00 lakh for the project named 'Storm Water Drainage System' of Bhubaneswar City approved on 26.02.2009 under Urban Infrastructure and Governance (UIG) submission of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM). The project has been appraised by the Ministry and sent to State of Odisha for its Compliance.

(c):The projects under UIG submission are considered for approval subject to their technical appraisal/compliance and availability of funds for the State.
