Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether some of the Public Sector Enterprises (PSEs) are running in profit;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the average amount earned annually during the last three years and the current year;
- (c) the capital invested in these PSEs by the Government during the last three years and the current year; and
- (d) the total number of employees working in these PSEs at present?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEAVY INDUSTRIES & PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI PRAFUL PATEL)

(a) to (d): Yes Madam. As per information available in the Public Enterprises Survey (2009-10) that was laid in the Parliament on 24.2.2011, there were 158 Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) which earned profit during 2009-10. The details of CPSEs which made profit continuously during the last three years and the capital invested in these CPSEs (in terms of equity and long term loans) are given at Annex 1. The total number of employees in these CPSEs stood at 8.45 lakh as on 31.3.2010. The CPSE-wise details of these employees are given in Annex 1.
