- (a) & (b) Government of India has initiated actions to review National Water Policy, 2002. A drafting committee has been set up to draft the National Water Policy taking into account the feedback received during consultation meetings held with the Members of Parliament, Academia, Experts & Professionals, Non-Governmental Organizations, Corporate Leaders and representatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions.
- (c) to (e) Government of India has launched National Water Mission under National Action Plan on Climate Change envisaging, interalia, review of National Water Policy, particularly with a view to ensure
- (i) integrated Water Resources Management for helping to conserve water, minimizing wastage and ensuring more equitable distribution,
- (ii) consideration of precipitation as basic water resource,
- (iii) evaporation management as an important strategy,
- (iv) basin level management strategies,
- (v) appropriate entitlement and pricing, and
- (vi) appropriate regulatory mechanism. A series of consultation meetings has been held with the Members of Parliament, Academia, Experts & Professionals, Non-Governmental Organizations, Corporate Leaders and representatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions regarding review of National Water Policy. A Drafting Committee has been set up to draft the National Water Policy.
