- (a) whether the Government has launched a single light system scheme for Below Poverty Line (BPL) households with 100 percent subsidy throughout the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof State-wise including Assam; and ;
- (c) the details of number of BPL households benefited through this scheme State-wise?

(a),(b)&(c): The Ministry has not launched a separate specific single light scheme for Below Poverty Line (BPL) households with 100% subsidy. However, a provision for providing a one light connection for BPL households with 100% support from the Ministry, subject to pre-specified maximum amounts, exists in the Remote Village Electrification (RVE) programme being implemented by the Ministry. As per information received from the State implementing Agencies, the State-wise details of BPL households covered in various projects submitted by State implementing Agencies under the RVE programme are given below:
