(a) to(c) In the first level examination of National Talent Search (NTS) Scheme, conducted by the State Government of Punjab on November 16, 2008, there were factual errors in the keys of some of the questions. National Council of Educational Research and Training, which conducts the second level of NTS examination, has taken up the matter with the State Government of Punjab, and has suggested to the State Government to incorporate adequate checks into the system so as to avoid such incidents in future.
