- (a) Whether the Union Government has prepared some proposal or Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) for the people living in the National Capital Territory (NCT) and adjoining cities for commuting to and from Delhi;
- (b) If so, the details thereof;
- (c) The areas of the neighbouring states of Delhi included under the RRTS;
- (d) Whether an NCR Transport Corporation has been set up for implementation of RRTS;
- (e) If so, the details thereof and
- (f) The details of the amount likely to be spent thereon alongwith the share of the centre and state therein?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA ROY)

- (a) to (c): NCR Planning Board prepared Functional Plan on Transportfor NCR-2032. The Plan recommended following eight Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) corridors to connect various towns/areas of National Capital Region:-
- 1 Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut
- 2 Delhi-Gurgaon-Rewari-Alwar
- 3 Delhi-Faridabad-Ballabgarh-Palwal
- 4 Ghaziabad-Khurja
- 5 Delhi-Sonipat-Panipat
- 6 Delhi-Bahadurgarh-Rohtak
- 7 Delhi-Ghaziabad-Hapur
- 8 Delhi-Shahadra-Baraut

Out of eight corridors, the Government of India prioritized following three corridors for implementation in consultation with State Governments:-

- $\hbox{i. Delhi-Gurgaon-Rewari-Alwar}\\$
- ii. Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut
- iii. Delhi-Sonipat-Panipat
