- (a) whether the Government has formulated any scheme for the development of coastal tourism in the country including Karnataka and Orissa;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action plan initiated/being initiated by the Government in this regard?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF TOURISM (KUMARI SELJA)

- (a) to (c): There is no specific scheme of the Ministry of Tourism for development of coastal tourism. However, Ministry of Tourism provides financial assistance to the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations for development and promotion of tourism including coastal tourism under the following Schemes:
- (i) Product/Infrastructure Development for Destinations and Circuits
- (ii) Large Revenue Generating projects
- (iii) Assistance to Central Agencies for Infrastructure Development
- (iv) Information Technology
- (v) Fairs, Festival and Events

Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned the following projects for development of coastal tourism in 2008-09:

- 1. Development of tourism infrastructure at Cochin Port, Kerala for Rs.1450.00 lakh to Cochin Port Trust, Kochi.
- 2. Purchase of Ferries in Tamil Nadu for Rs.52.70 lakh to Poompuhar Shipping Corporation Ltd, Chennai
