- (a) the names of works undertaken/being undertaken by various State Governments with the funds allocated by the Union Government to develop and promote tourism in those States during last three years, State-wise and work-wise;
- (b) the details of such schemes along with the names of projects sanctioned thereunder and the funds utilised by the State Governments since inception, State-wise, project-wise and scheme-wise;
- (c) whether these schemes have been/are being implemented satisfactorily;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government for effective implementation of these schemes?

(a) to (e): State/Union Territory-wise details of projects sanctioned by Ministry of Tourism for development and promotion of tourism during the last 3 years are at Annexure.

Implementation of projects is primarily the responsibility of the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. The Ministry of Tourism however, monitors the progress of implementation through review meetings with them and site visits from time to time.
