- (a) whether the Uttar Pradesh Government has submitted any proposal to the Union Government for construction of a bridge at Pachpedi Ghat across the river Sharda on National Highway No. 21;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the likely expenditure to be incurred thereon; and
- (c) the time by which the said proposal is likely to be approved?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (c): No Madam. Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways in the country. The matter pertains to State Govt of Uttar Pradesh as the bridge at Pachpedi Ghat across the river Sharda falls on State Highway-21 and not on National Highway. No proposal for construction of this bridge has been received from State Government of Uttar Pradesh.
