## Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Huda Committee has submitted its report on the MSP of agricultural produce;
- (b) if so, the details of the recommendations made in the report; and
- (c) the time by which the Government proposes to implement the recommendations contained therein?

## **Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE, FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES AND PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS (SHRI HARISH RAWAT)

(a) to (c): Yes, Madam. The Hooda Committee has made a number of recommendations which, inter alia, include provision of credit for agricultural loans at not more than 4 % per annum rate of interest; review of methodology adopted by Commission for Agriculture Cost and Prices (CACP); supported adoption of National Commission on Farmers` recommendation of 50% higher Minimum Support Price (MSP) over the actual cost of production; bridge the horizontal and vertical gaps in yield; expansion of area under boro (winter) rice etc.

The decisions on the recommendations of the Committee are taken by the Government after consultation with the stake holders.
