(a) No madam. As per Livestock Censuses, number of indigenous cattle in the country has increased from 160.495 million in 2003 to 166.015 million in 2007.

(b) Does not arise.

(c) & (d) No, Madam. However, Government is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme namely, 'National Project for Cattle and Buffalo Breeding' (NPCBB) envisages genetic upgradation of bovines on priority basis. The project also has focus on development and conservation of indigenous breeds.
