- i) Aam Aadmi Bima Yojana (AABY)
- ii) Janashree Bima Yojana (JBY)
- iii) Universal Health Insurance Scheme (UHIS)
- iv) Rashtriya Swastha Bima Yojana (RSBY) by Ministry of Labour and Employment
- v) Mahatma Gandhi Bunkar Bima Yojana by Ministry of Textiles.
