(a)&(b) There is no state-of-the-art airport made operational during the current year. However, during the current year new terminal buildings were made operational at Amritsar (Punjab), Aurangabad (Maharashtra), Dibrugarh (Assam), Jaipur (Rajasthan), Srinagar (Jammu & Kashmir), Surat (Gujarat), Trichy (Tamil Nadu) and Vishkapatnam (Andhra Pradesh).The cost of the new Terminal Buildings at these airports were borne entirely by the Airports Authority of India.
