- (a) Yes, Madam.
- (b) The new forms Sahaj (Form ITR-1) and Sugam (Form ITR-4S) were introduced for Assessment Year 2011-12, vide Notification No.18/2011, S.O.693(E) dated 5th April, 2011.
- (c) The objective is to simplify the process of filing of income tax returns for individual taxpayers.
- (d) Both the income tax return forms are annexure-less and can also be e-filed. These forms are easy to fill and would enable faster processing of returns.
