(a) The Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) has informed that the number of LIC agents as on 31.03.2011 are 13,37,064 in the country.

(b) Functions of the LIC agents are prescribed in Rule 8 of the Life Insurance Corporation of India (Agents) Rules, 1972 and the percentage of commission paid to LIC agents depends upon the insurance plans and premium paying terms.

(c) & (d) Yes, the main function of the LIC agents is to procure new business for the Corporation in the form of number of policies and premium. During the financial year 2010-11, LIC Agents have procured 3,33,43,756 policies with First Year Premium of Rs. 51,190.04 crore.
