Answer

MINISTER OF DRINKING WATER AND SANITATION (SHRI JAIRAM RAMESH)

- (a) In the National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), powers for fixing the norms for providing drinking water supply, including for installation of handpumps, to rural areas have been delegated to the States. In the NRDWP guidelines, for purposes of comparability, coverage means provision of potable drinking water supply within a distance of 500 metres from the household or 30 minutes of time taken for fetching water.
